SECARB Phase III  
Anthropogenic Test Site Details**

On May 21, 2009, Southern Company issued a press release identifying the future site of the SECARB Phase III Anthropogenic Test and details regarding the integrated carbon dioxide (CO<sub>2</sub>) capture, transportation and injection project design. The CO<sub>2</sub> will be captured (through a component paid for under separate funding) at Alabama Power Company's Plant Barry, located in Bucks, Alabama. The SECARB research team will transport the CO<sub>2</sub> by pipeline approximately 10 miles and inject it into a saline geologic formation accessed from an area of the Citronelle Oil Field operated by Denbury Resources.
